Parade Entry Rules/Guidelines

- Please complete parade application in its entirety and returned signed application (page 1)

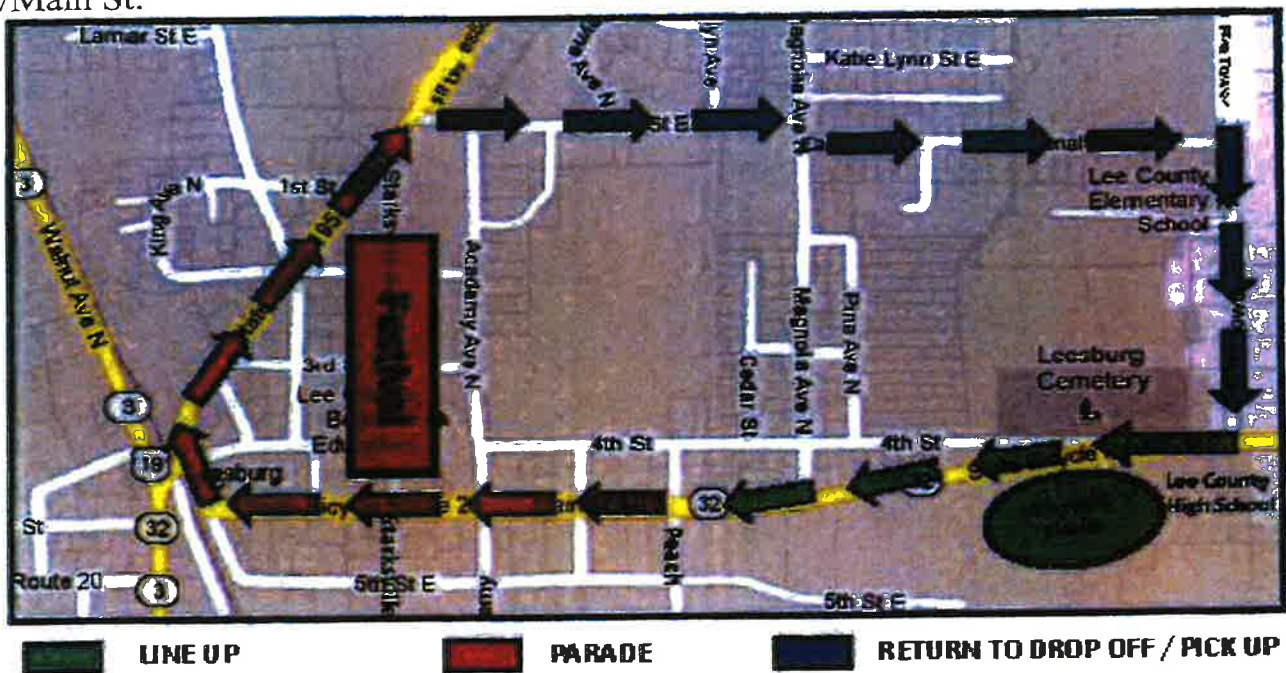
and the description of your entry (page 2) to the office along with your entry fee. Parade applications are due no later than Friday, May 31, 2024. ***(No application will be accepted after this day)***. No entry will be allowed in the parade line-up without the completed signed application.

- The parade entry fee is \$20.00 monetary donation to assist Lee County's Recovery & Restoration House, Inc. to purchase promotional materials to make the parade a memorable and impactful event. Additionally, any excess funds would directly support our efforts to provide necessities for our shelter and contribute to the building of the shelter in Lee County.
- Float/entry must adhere to the application description, be entertaining to all ages, and decorated in festive and freedom day celebration style.
- We ask that you strictly adhere to this requirement in order to keep your entry from being disqualified.
- **MUSIC** Any unit using sound must play jazz, or gospel freedom music only. This is a moving parade. NO stopping at any time during the parade route. Failure to comply could result in removal in future parades.
- If you plan to distribute candy from your vehicle/float to the crowd during the parade you **MUST** have personnel walking on **BOTH SIDES** of the vehicle/float to assure that no children get under the vehicle/float and become injured. Failure to adhere to this requirement will result in ***not being permitted*** to distribute candy during the parade. Our liability insurance will not cover any injuries resulting from negligence in adhering to this rule.
- Parade line-up is on Highway 32 in front of the Lee County High School.
You must be lined up by 9:00AM SHARP, in your assigned location.

• PLEASE NOTE THAT THE PARADE MUST HAVE CONSTANT MOVEMENT – PLEASE MAINTAIN AT LEAST 1 CAR LENGTH BETWEEN ALL UNITS. DO NOT DISBAND UNTIL YOU HAVE REACHED THE END / PICK UP AREA.

DRIVER OF VEHICLE/FLOAT: For safety concerns we ask that Parade participants, please **DO NOT** enter the parade line-up by traveling East on Hwy 32/Main Street and making a U-Turn or by turning around in ANY of the front High School parking lots. We ask that you come from the direction of Lovers Lane Rd so that you are traveling in the direction of the parade route. If you are traveling from the East side of town, please take Robert B Lee and make a left onto Lovers Lane, and then left onto Hwy 32/Main St. We will use one of the lots for staging our Horse Riders. **PLEASE DO NOT** use Peach Ave. or Starksville Ave. to travel East onto Hwy 32/Main Street as these roads will be blocked off at 32/Main St.
